SECONDARY CAREER/VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL PROGRAMS IN
HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT**

To receive credit for the above mentioned Middlesex Community College courses, students must:

1. graduate from a Massachusetts Chapter 74 Approved Secondary Career/Vocational Technical Program in Hospitality Management. 2. earn a minimum high school grade point average of 2.0 and a cumulative average of "B" (3.00/80% or higher) in the courses that comprise the program listed above
3. meet all Middlesex admissions requirements and be a matriculated student in good standing
4. submit to Middlesex Enrollment Services an official high school transcript documenting graduation as well as the documentation listed above
