CHELMSFORD HIGH SCHOOL Articulation Agreement with MIDDLESEX COMMUNITY COLLEGE

To receive credit at Middlesex Community College, Chelmsford High School students must:

- 1. Apply and be admitted to Middlesex Community College.
- 2. Graduate from Chelmsford High School and earn a minimum grade of "B" (80%) in the Chelmsford High School courses for which credit is awarded.
- Submit an official Chelmsford High School academic transcript documenting graduation to Middlesex Community College's Enrollment Communications Department.
- 4. Enroll in courses at Middlesex Community College.

Students may apply this articulated credit to any Middlesex Community College certificate or associate degree program that can accommodate the credit.
