This pathway is intended as the first 1-2 semesters for students who are interested in a health program. These courses will meet requirements in many of the health programs and/or will prepare students to continue on to complete program prerequisite requirements. All students are encouraged to attend a Health Program Information session for a general overview of the health programs offered at Middlesex Community College. There are also specific information sessions for some of the programs that are required for admission to the program. These include Dental Assisting, Dental Hygiene, Diagnostic Medical Sonography, and Nursing.

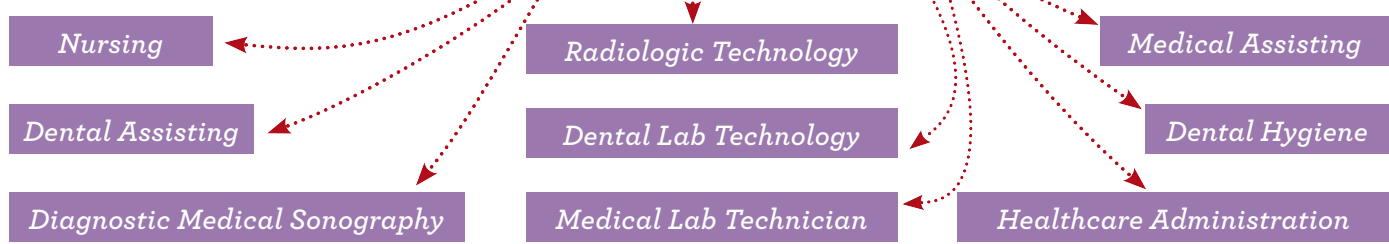
