General Advising Notes

- CRJ 111 is the pre-requisite for CRJ 112 and CRJ 231.
- ENG 101 is the prerequisite for CRJ 151, CRJ 131, and CRJ 231.
- If a student has placed in Preparation for College Math, modules 1-12 must be completed. Students should be advised to start the Math sequence as soon as possible to allow time to complete it.
- CRJ 112 is a prerequisite for CRJ 152.
- CRJ 152 is a prerequisite for CRJ 241.
- Students are advised to take CRJ 151 after completing at least one other CRJ course, preferably CRJ 111, and not to postpone enrolling in it until the last semester.
- Students can choose any course as a Free Elective including any CRJ course.
- Humanities are courses with the following prefixes: ART, COM, DAN, ENG, ETH, HUM, LAN, MUS, PHL, REL, THE.
- No academic credit is awarded for life experience, nor for military, police academy or other training.
