Milestone Courses should be taken in the order shown. This will help you stay on track and graduate on time.

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General Advising Notes

- PSY 122 is the prerequisite for most EDU courses.
- Students are encouraged to take Math in their first semester to allow time for completion.
- All ECE students must take IDS 101 within the first 30 • credits of the degree.
- EDU 101 and EDU 153 or EDU 150 are the pre-requisites for the program capstone EDU 251.
- A one credit IDS course must be chosen to complete the 3 credit Elective cluster. A one credit IDS course must be chosen to complete 3 credits: IDS 102 -General Education Seminar: service Learning, IDS 103 – General Education Seminar: Leadership, IDS 104 – General Education Seminar: Research, IDS 105 – General Education Seminar: Interdisciplinary Weekend, IDS 106 – General Education Seminar: Career Exploration, IDS 107 - General Education Seminar: Career Development, IDS 108 – General Education Seminar: Wellness, IDS 109 – General Education Seminar: Grappling with Wicked Problems.
- Social Science Electives are courses with the following prefixes: ECO, GGY, GOV, HST, PSY, SOC. GGY 120, World Geography is recommended as the Social Science elective for students contemplating a switch to the ECE Transfer option.
- ENG 113, Classics of Children's Literature is recommended as Humanities Elective.
- Humanities are courses with the following prefixes: ART, COM, DAN, ENG, ETH, HUM, LAN, MUS, PHL, REL, THE. ART 101, Art Appreciation is recommended as Humanities for students contemplating a switch to the ECE Transfer option.
- Science Electives are courses with the following prefixes: BIO, CHE, ENV, PHY, SCI. SCI 121 - Integrated Science I and SCI 122 – Integrated Science II are recommended as SCI Electives for students contemplating a switch to the ECE Transfer option.
