Career and Transfer Outlook

- UMass Lowell requires the Lab Science Option for the Liberal Arts and Science Degree: one science course must be a lab science and can be a non-lab science.
- UMass Lowell requires a one semester survey
 of British Literature while Salem State
 requires two literature courses from different
 time periods (a two semester sequence such
 as, American Literature I and II or World
 Literature I and II).
- UMass Lowell requires four semesters of a World Languages for Literature majors, so students planning to transfer to UMass Lowell are encouraged to complete at least two semesters of the same language as electives before transferring. Salem State does not have a language requirement for English majors.
