- Students will complete two semesters of World Language B. Currently, MCC offers two or more semesters of the following languages: Arabic, Chinese, Finnish, French, German, Greek, Italian, Japanese, Khmer, Latin, Portuguese, Spanish and Russian.

Recommended Electives

Free Electives Recommended: REL 101 – Religions of the World –or– GGY 120 – World Geography –or– REL 102 – Religions of Asia –or– SOC 118 – Multicultural Communications.

Science Electives Recommended: ENV 115 – Environmental Studies and ENV 131 – Environmental Science with Lab.

Literature Electives Recommended: ENG 140 – World Literature I –or– ENG 141 – World Literature II –or– ENG 175 – Irish Literature –or– ENG 120 – The Holocaust –or– ENG 125 – Literature of Protest and Hope.
