- Recommended studio art, and general education electives advised by art faculty are to help students develop their portfolio for transfer.
- Students should routinely save artwork from each class to aid in building the required portfolio.

Career and Transfer Outlook

Most students in the Studio Art degree program continue their studies toward a bachelor's degree. Students should check the requirements of the transfer institution and meet with career and academic/transfer counselors at MCC for specific program planning.
