## General Advising Notes

## Advanced Placement for Licensed Practical Nurses

Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) who meet MCC's Nursing program admission requirements may apply for advanced placement on a spaceavailable basis. LPNs may request credit for prior learning and apply those credits to an Associate in Science Degree in Nursing.
