JOB SEARCH & NETWORKING

Searching and applying for jobs takes patience and perseverance. Networking is a tool that can increase your opportunities and decrease the time you spend searching.

Ways to Conduct Your Job or Internship Search

- Passive Search: Search on job boards such as OptimalResume.com or SimplyHired.com. Industry-specific job boards also exist, such as Dice.com, Archinect.com, and Gamejobs.com. The second page of this handout has industry-specific boards. Select a few job boards and set up an email alert to be notified when new jobs are posted. Always start with Optimal Resume, as these are employers looking specifically for MCC students.
- Active Search: Often more effective than the passive search create a target list of companies for which you are interested in working. Search each company's website for job postings, follow their Twitter feed and LinkedIn page, and reach out to them directly for information about opportunities.
- Networking: Usually the most effective way of searching for positions. Sometimes jobs are filled without ever making it to job boards. Find out about these positions by connecting with individuals in your field. Informational interviews are one of the best ways to network and expand your connections.

What is Networking?

- Using existing relationships to create connections and gain more in-depth knowledge about industry standards and requirements, career paths, company cultures, and types of jobs.
- Use networking to:
 - Explore career options, research industries, and learn about specific companies.
 - Uncover leads for potential job opportunities.
 - Gain advice on improving chances of getting hired.
 - Build a community of people with whom you share a professional interest.
 - Promote yourself as someone entering the industry.

How to Find People for Networking

- Professional Associations: Join professional associations to find out about conferences or events being held in your field. These can also help you learn about what is happening in your industry, find industry-specific job sites, and add something extra to your resume. Many professional associations have groups on LinkedIn that you can join as well.
- MCC Alumni: Attend alumni events to connect or search for MCC alumni on LinkedIn. Select the "Find Alumni" section under the "My Network" tab. You do not need to be a premium member on LinkedIn to message people as long as you are both a member of the same group another good reason to join professional association groups on LinkedIn
- Former or Current Colleagues: Build good relationships while you are at your internships so you can utilize them to connect with other professionals in the field.
- *Professors*: Reach out to your professors to set up an informational interview or to ask for recommendations of whom to connect with within the field.
- CareerCon and Career Fairs: Use on-campus opportunities to connect with employers and alumni.
- People Already in Your Network (friends, family, classmates, neighbors, etc.): Tell everyone you know that you are looking for an internship or a job, as you never know who they might know.

Tips for Networking

• Do your homework. Do research through LinkedIn and the company's website about the people you are meeting and be prepared with at least two areas of common interest.
