### **PURPOSE**

To assist a student in pursuing a degree in Business or Communications.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- The applicant must be pursuing a degree in Business or Communications.
- The applicant must have a 2.5 or better.
- The applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- The applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credit hours per semester.

### **AMOUNT**

Up to \$1,000 for tuition and fees or related educational expenses.

### **GUIDELINES**

This scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis and will be disbursed at the outset of the spring semester. The MCC Foundation working with the family of Paul Sullivan and the appropriate college committee has the exclusive responsibility for screening all applicants and selecting an appropriate recipient for this award.

### **TO APPLY**
