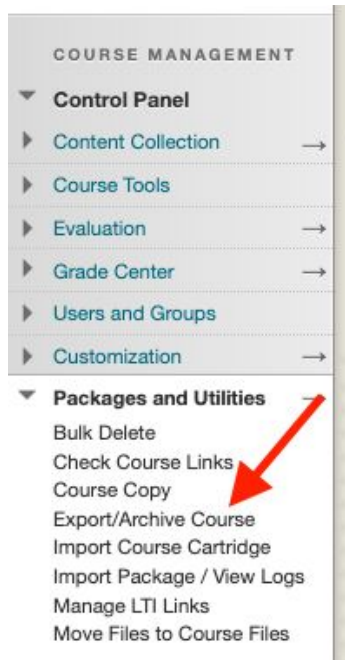


REVIEWING YOUR COURSE'S ESTIMATED FILE SIZE

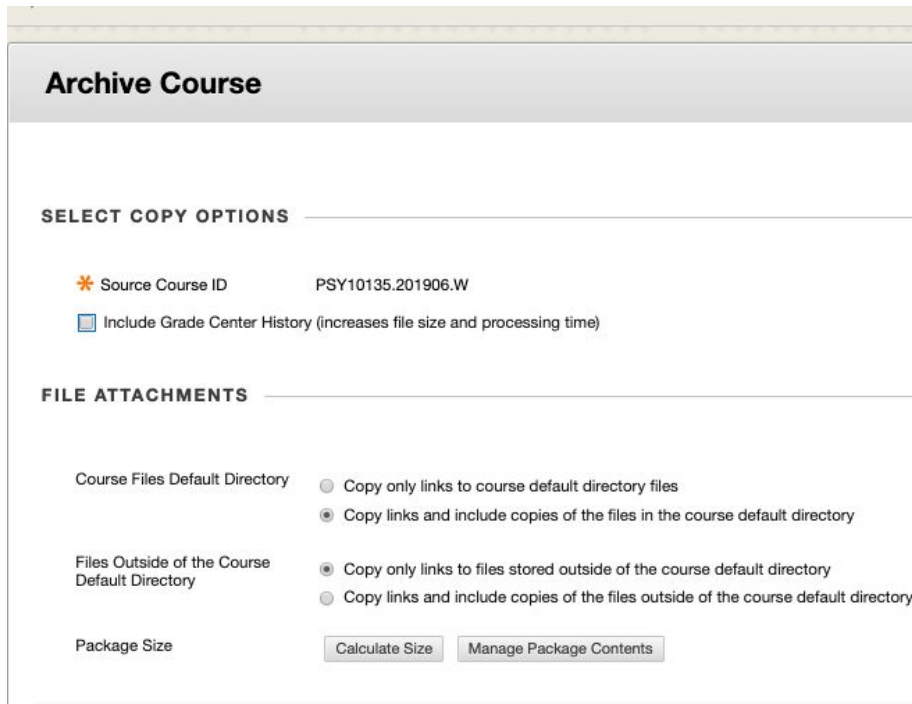
Each course's overall file size must stay within the range of **500 MB to 1 GB**. You may check your course's file size when logged into Blackboard by following these steps:

1. Navigate to the course that you want to review. In the course's **CONTROL PANEL**, click on **PACKAGES UTILITIES** and select **ARCHIVE/EXPORT COURSE** from the menu of tools.



2. On the Export/Archive Course page, click on the **ARCHIVE COURSE** button.

3. On the Archive Course page, scroll down to the **PACKAGE SIZE** section and click on the **CALCULATE SIZE** button.
