Please be aware of DEADLINES for all items!

- Complete your degree.**
 - Review your *My Degree Audit* in myMCC
- Apply to graduate in your last semester.** ([MyMCC left side](#))

- Application Type** – Which application(s) can you use?

 - Common Application – <https://apply.transfer.commonapp.org/>
 - School's Applications
- Application Materials** – Do you need....
 - Application Essay?
 - Recommendation Letters?
 - Request Early!! (At least one is an MCC professor)
 - Application Fee? (You can ask if there is a way to waive this fee.)
- Transcripts** – ([MyMCC left side](#))
 - <https://www.middlesex.mass.edu/transfer/transcript.aspx>
 - Middlesex Community College – Send with application
Send again after graduation
 - All other colleges attended – Contact those schools to have transcripts sent.
 - Request from CollegeBoard any CLEP or AP tests you would like to receive credit for.
- Financial Aid – FAFSA** – <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>
 - Most schools require FAFSA. March 1st is a common priority deadline
 - CSS profile – Check to see if your school(s) requires it.
- Scholarships** – <https://www.middlesex.mass.edu/transfer/scholarships.aspx>
 - Start here, but apply for all that you find and are eligible for.
 - Some scholarships require that you complete the FAFSA.
- School Specific** – Check with your school to see if additional items are required.
 - Portfolio or Audition for arts programs
 - Syllabus for each course or course descriptions
 - Housing Application
 - Orientation
 - Etc.
