MIDDLESEX COMMUNITY COLLEGE and RIVIER UNIVERSITY
A.S. BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION TRANSFER to B.S. BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

Beginning with the 2013-2014 academic year, the Division of Business at Rivier University agrees to accept into its Baccalaureate Program in Business Management; students who have graduated from the Middlesex Community College's associate degree program in Business Administration with a minimum grade-point average of 2.0 (C) and who satisfactorily complete the following requirements for admission:

- Completes the requirements of the Associate of Science in Business Administration concentrations as listed in the Middlesex Community College catalog, and;
- Successfully achieve a 2.0 (C) cumulative GPA upon completion of their degree program;
- Submits application for transfer to the Admissions Office at Rivier University
- Accompany application for transfer admission with a \$25 non-refundable fee
- Indicates Transfer Articulation Program (TAP) on transfer application
- Submits a complete official transcript from Middlesex Community College
- Submit all other required documents for admission, as required by the application process.

A written notification of transfer admission will be mailed to each applicant by the Admissions Office. Middlesex Community College graduates transferring to Rivier University through this articulation agreement may complete their remaining requirements for the baccalaureate degree in two years full-time, or four to six years part-time study.

This agreement is ongoing, and is predicated on annual review by both parties, especially as it pertains to continued comparability of curriculum, where appropriate. This agreement is subject to catalog and/or program revisions at both institutions; however, this agreement will continue to apply to students who transfer from the Middlesex Community College's program within one year of the expiration of this agreement.
